1. Background

Bread for the City is a Washington, DC-based nonprofit organization providing wraparound direct services—including food, clothing, medical care, legal and social services, and behavioral health—to residents living with low income. Grounded in dignity, equity, and community, our mission is to help Washington, DC residents living with low income to develop their power to determine the future of their own communities. We provide food, clothing, medical care, and legal and social services to reduce the burden of poverty. We seek justice through community organizing and public advocacy. We work to uproot racism, a major cause of poverty. We are committed to treating our clients with the dignity and respect that all people deserve.

Bread for the City seeks a vendor to design and fully deploy a network technology refresh across its two offices. This refresh should upgrade old equipment to modern solutions with extended warranties that will be easy to manage, enhance security and enable scalable growth. This initiative will revitalize the core compute and storage infrastructure that underpins the organization’s virtual servers at its two locations. In addition, the campus wired and wireless networks will be modernized, providing improved connectivity and performance throughout each facility. BFC hopes to upgrade the firewall and SD-WAN solutions, ensuring robust protection against evolving cyber threats while supporting seamless network access across locations and to roughly 40 remote users.

2. Scope of Work

Bread for the City (BFC) seeks a data center and network refresh that includes equipment, warranties, installation and configuration of it's data center, physical and virtual environments, remote connectivity, firewalls, networking hardware, and SD-WAN technology.

Current Infrastructure

BFC is currently utilizing Dell Servers with a VMWare environment, Sonicwall firewalls, a VeloCloud SDWAN solution, and Rukus Wireless system. 40 remote users connect remotely through Sonicwall VPN and Duo 2 factor authentication.

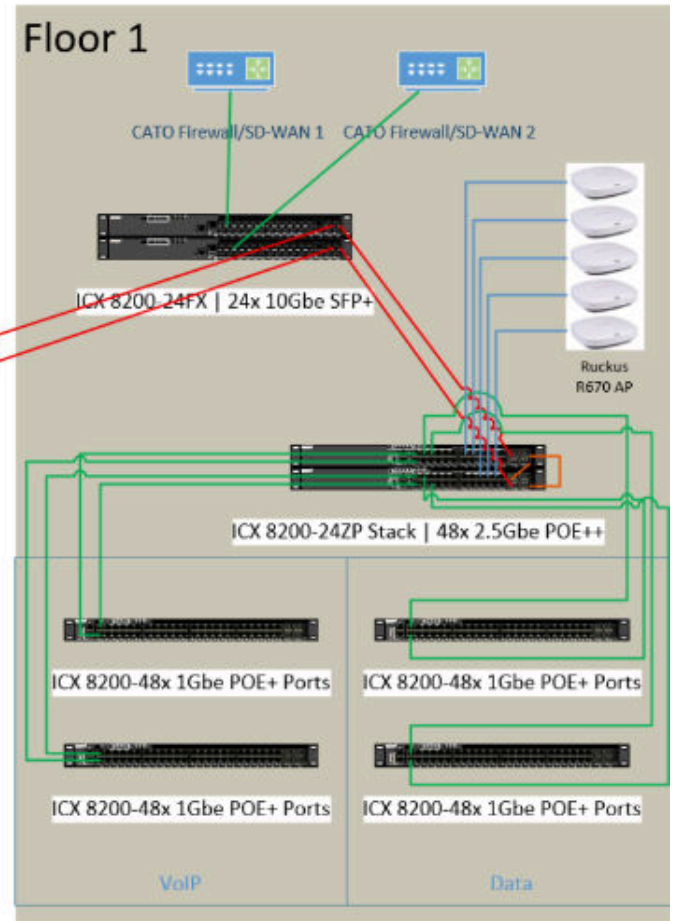
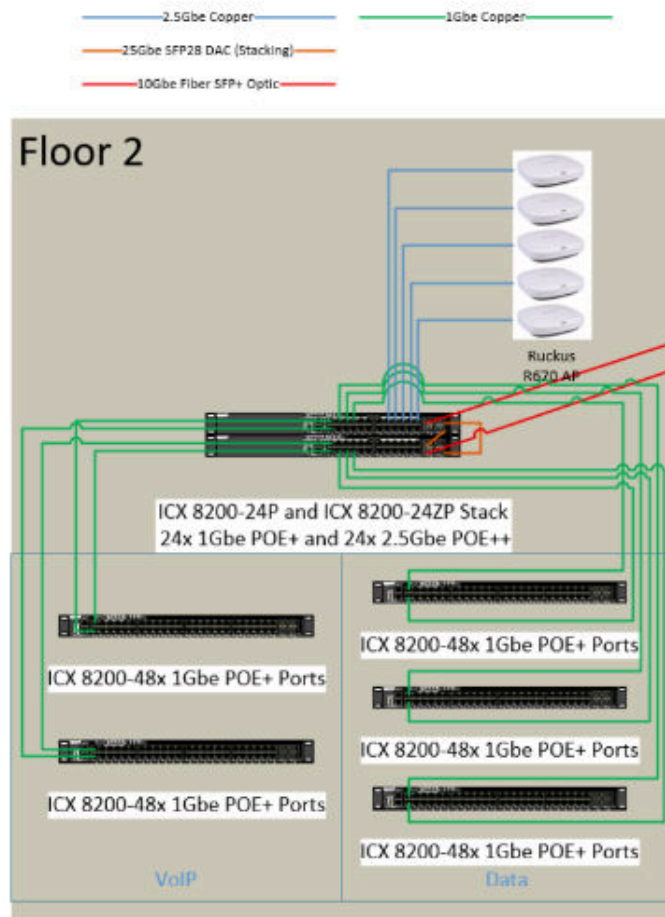
### ***New proposed architecture:***

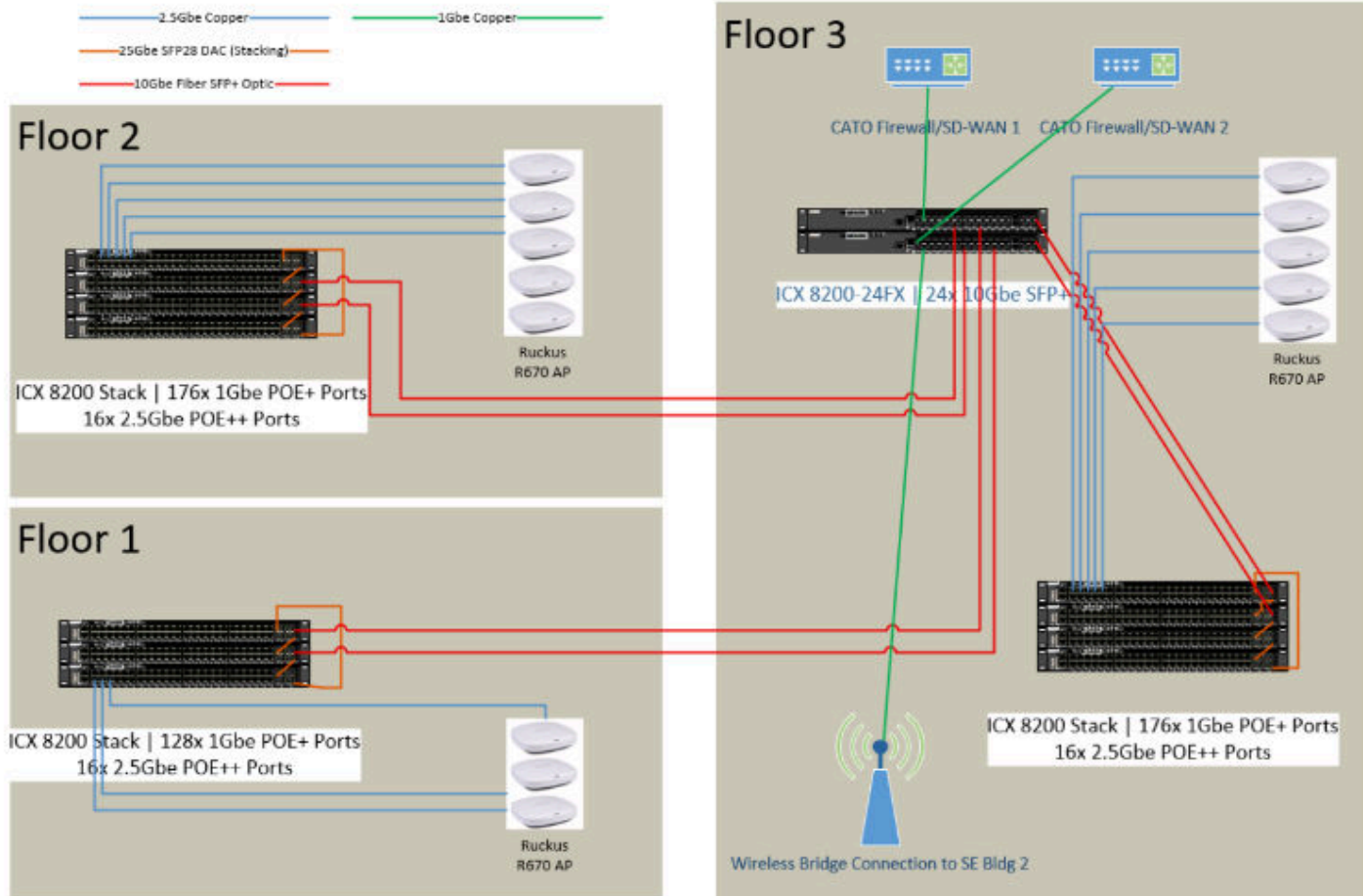

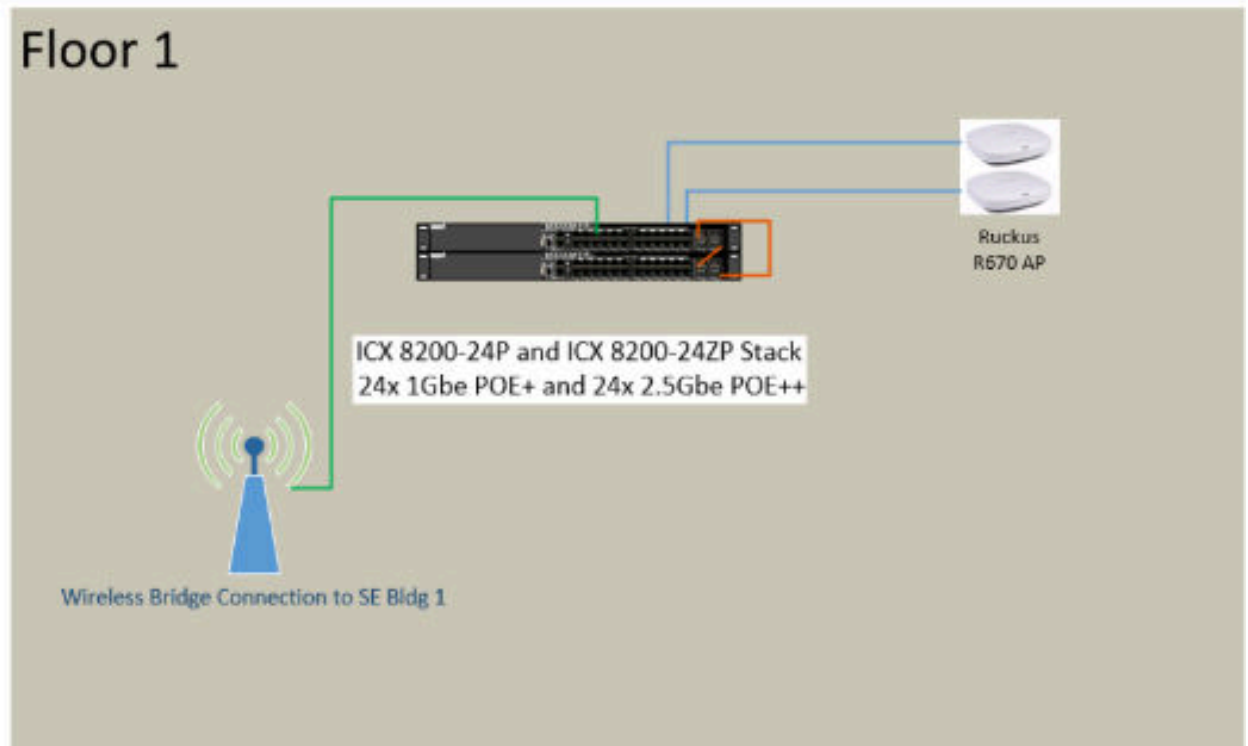
# NW Center - 1525 7th St NW

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### 4. Proposal Requirements

Interested vendors should submit a proposal that includes:

- Agency Overview: Background, mission, core capabilities, and experience with nonprofit clients—especially those in social services.
- Approach: Strategic vision for omnichannel donor engagement, including segmentation, donor journeys, and behavioral science integration.
- Team: Description of the team we would work with.
- References: Contact information for at least three nonprofit clients.
- Budget: Line-item budget for the proposed services.

- Timeline: Project milestones, onboarding schedule, and launch plan.

Proposals will be evaluated based on:

- Alignment with budget.
  - Alignment with Bread for the City's values.
  - Demonstrated expertise.
  - Support offerings.
  - Project management capabilities and team strength.
